linoleum

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At first glance, the linoleum top might look to be a different colour than the one you originally picked out. No need to worry – this is only temporary. Linoleum is made from natural raw materials. During the manufacturing process to create a strong yet springy material, the surface may develop a yellowish cast due to oxidation, a so-called drying room film. As soon as linoleum is exposed to daylight, the yellowing disappears. To eliminate this film, simply place your new table in direct sunlight after taking it out of the box. In bright sunlight, the yellowing will disappear in only a few hours. This can take up to several weeks in artificial light, depending on the intensity of the light source.

MAINTENANCE/CLEANING

For everyday cleaning, use a soft, clean and damp cotton cloth (no microfibres). Localized dirt can also be removed with a soft, white eraser. It is important that the eraser does not contain any abrasives. Similar spots based on waterpermeable flower pots, vases etc. can be avoided by appropriate table mats and coasters.

Liquids must be immediately wiped with a soft cloth. Hot items (from 70 °C on) must not be placed directly on linoleum. In no case linoleum may come into contact with alkaline agents. They will damage the surface and thus the "self-healing properties" of the material.
